Our Topic this Term is "It's Fun to be Me!"

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

The children will be settling in to their classes and getting to know their teachers and each other. The children will learn to be independent and active learners. We will be discussing ourselves, our feelings and what makes us feel happy and proud.

Communication and Language:

Children will develop their speaking and listening skills though circle times, stories and conversations about their learning and interests. We will be building a collection of songs and rhymes which they can share with you at home.

Expressive Arts and Design:

Children will have lots of opportunities to learn techniques to explore media. They will be encouraged to express themselves creatively through dance, music and role play.

Understanding the World:

Children will share their experiences of families. We will be celebrating all the many languages we hear and speak at home.

Physical Development:

We will begin handwriting practise to improve letter formation. Children will use tools such as paintbrushes, scissors and tweezers throughout their learning environment.

Maths

The children will be learning to count all kinds of things that we can touch and play with. We will start to draw pictures to show our understanding of how many things there are altogether.

The children will compare objects and groups, and talk about how they are "the same" or "different". We will use language to talk about size, height and length, and will create a class height chart.

English

Our focus will be on books and stories, which children will learn to respond to through writing. Our key texts will be Owl Babies by Martin Waddell, Titch by Pat Hutchins, Things I Like by Anthony Browne and So Much by Trish Cooke. Children will be introduced to letters and their sounds during daily phonics.

Home learning

We ask that you share a book with your child every day. There will be two books inside your child's book baa:

- 1) A book that your child has chosen from the book corner.
- 2) A reading book at their level. We will communicate via the reading record. Please fill this in to tell us how your child is responding to books. Thank you!
