- Use paints, felt tips or crayons to create a bright cartoon picture
- Cut and stick bits from a magazine or newspaper to create a collage

**Support** – You may want to ask your children some questions to support their art skills:

- What shape is the body?
- What shape are the eyes, beak/mouth and legs?
- How many legs are there?
- What textures can you see?
- How many different colours can you see?
- Which parts are darkest? Which parts are lightest?

**Challenge**–

- Label the different body parts on your chick picture.
- Write a caption at the bottom to sum up your artwork.
- Use a sentence including adjectives to describe your favourite chick.
