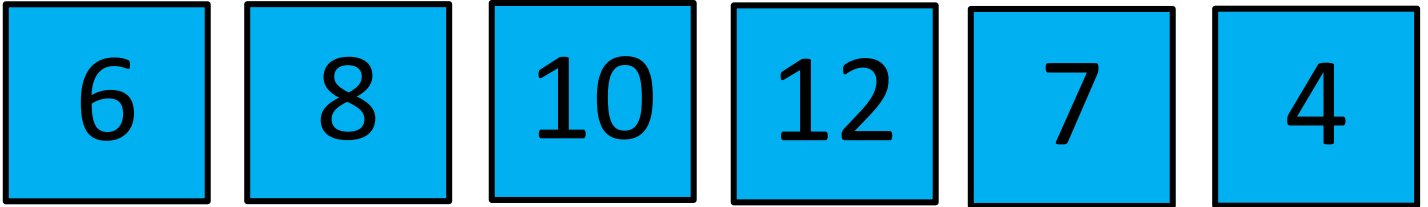


Year 1 - Home Learning

Spring Term 1 - Week 4 Multiplication

We have been learning how to group objects as an introduction to multiplication. We have been learning that *'multiplication or x'* means *'groups of'*.

Choose a number card. Use objects around the home (seeds, straws, spoons, buttons, lego blocks) and make 2 equal groups of that number into bowls or plates.



For example, if I chose:



First place the number of buttons on your card in each bowl.


Ask these questions to help you work out the answer:

How many bowls/groups do you have?

How many in each bowl/group?

How many altogether?

How could you record this? You could use:

- Part, part, whole circles 
- A repeated addition number sentence $3 + 3 = 6$ or a multiplication number sentence $2 \times 3 = 6$
- A number problem and say it out loud:

"There are 2 bowls and each bowl has 3 buttons. There are 6 buttons altogether"

CHALLENGE: Can you do this with a different amount of groups/bowls? e.g. 3 or 5 bowls
