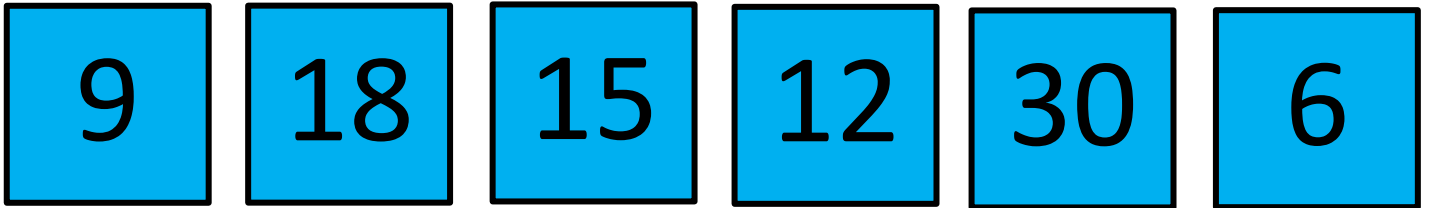


This week we have been learning how to divide (share) objects.

Choose a number card.

Use objects around the home (seeds, straws, spoons, buttons, lego blocks) and share them out equally into 3 bowls or plates.



For example: If I chose:



First select your total amount of objects. Then share them equally between the bowls.

Record your number problem using our whole and part circles or a number sentence ($6 \div 3 = 2$).

Ask these questions to help you with your recording:

How many objects altogether?

How many groups are there?

How many objects in each group?

Challenge:

Can you find any other numbers that will divide equally between 3?

Can you think of your own number stories dividing by 2 or 5?

How many different ways can you share the number 20 equally?
