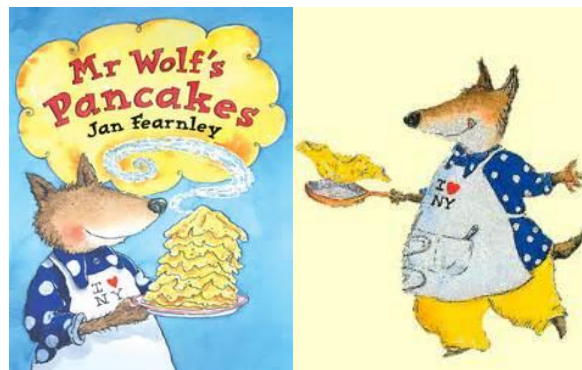


Oh no! The instructions are all muddled up! Watch this short clip on 'How to make the perfect pancake', cut out the pictures and stick them in the right order in your home learning book.
